



Immunization Requirements

Student must provide proof of these immunizations:

Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)

____ Two doses of the vaccine after the 1st birthday at least 30 days apart or provide proof of immunity to measles, mumps and rubella (titer). All students are required to provide proof.

Hepatitis B

____ Hepatitis B is a series of 3 injections. Usually takes 6 months to complete. Or the student can provide proof of immunity to Hepatitis B (titer). All students are required to provide proof. Students can request an informed refusal if the shot record is unavailable.

Tetanus / Diphtheria / Pertussis (Tdap)

____ Tetanus/ Diphtheria/Pertussis booster within 10 years. All students are required to provide proof.

Tuberculosis (TB)

____ Documentation of negative screening results for tuberculosis. Students must complete one of the following TB tests no more than 30 days prior to the program start date and recommended annually thereafter:

2-Step Tuberculin Skin Test (this means two separate tests at least 7 days apart);

QuantiFERON®-TB Gold InTube test (QFT-GIT or Q-Gold)

T-SPOT®TB test (T-Spot)

If student has positive results for a TB Test, a chest x-ray must be obtained.

All students are required to provide proof.

Varicella (Chicken Pox)

____ Must provide proof of Varicella (chicken pox) vaccination or immunity (titer). All students are required to provide proof. Students can also document history of illness of a special form.

Influenza (flu)

____ The flu shot is required for all students attending Clinical Rotations between October 1st and May 31st.

Bacterial Meningitis

____ This shot is not required but strongly recommended.

COVID-19 Vaccine

____ This vaccine is not required by all clinical sites but is strongly recommended. Students can sign an informed refusal.
